### **Student Council**

Student Council is an organization conducted by students and supervised by adults. The purpose of the student council is to give students an opportunity to develop leadership by organizing and carrying out school activities and service projects. In addition to planning events that contribute to school spirit and community welfare, the council will share student ideas, interests and concerns with the school wide community.

It is imperative that our student body take an active, and visible role in our school family. The student council should be an institution of respect and authority in the school, that can affect change in the most positive, and needed way possible.

All students willing to run for office must be in good academic standing, exhibit exemplary behavior and be approved by their teachers and parents. All students running for office as the President, Vice President,, Treasurer, and Secretary are required to construct a school platform and speech. (They can also create a campaign poster) The positions are listed below.

**President-** Must be in 8th grade

- Preside over and conduct regularly scheduled meetings.
- Give guidance, support and leadership to school activities approved by the administration.

**Vice President-** Must be in 7th or 8th grade

Attend all Student Council meetings Work closely with the President to give guidance, support and leadership to school activities approved by the administration.

**Treasurer-** Must be in grades 6, 7 or 8

- Attend all Student Council meetings
- Responsible for keeping track of the student body monies.

**Secretary**-Must be in grades 6, 7 or 8

- Attend all Student Council meetings
- Keep an accurate record of the school business in each meeting

**Grade level Representatives**- grades 2-8

Attend all Student Council meetings

- Assist the Student Council in the conduct of its business
- Represent the grade level concerns and inform grade levels of upcoming events
